


# 5-YEAR PROGRAM INCOME COMPARISON

#### 2021 Achievements and Accomplishments

- As of January 5, 2021, maintained ministry operations for 17 years.
- Received \$50,204.84 in monetary contributions, despite a 10% decrease compared to last year's revenue.
- The five-year comparison shows funding from \$26,411.32 (2017) to \$50,204.84 (2021). The
  ministry continues to grow financially; as much, activities 2022 will continue to be based on
  expected increase in revenue and COVID restrictions.
- Maintained partnership with Nicholas House Homeless Shelter. Sponsored 12 feedings.
- Maintained partnership with Care 4 All Children Services
- Developed new partnership with Because One Matters Foster Care Agency.
- Hosted Hybrid HTPP and pampered women from Bethel Family Church
- Held fundraiser (Back-to-School, shelter feedings, 1<sup>st</sup> responder feedings
- Raised \$15,871.
- Provided tutoring services from October through December 2021 to within Care 4 All Children Services.
- Hosted COVID Adopt-A-Family Program. Prepared for 52 families. Families receive \$125
   Publix gift cards, bibles, non-perishables, and food boxes. Families' referrals were obtained from Bethel Baptist, Foster Because One Matters, Berean Christian Church, Alpha-Phi-Alpha Fraternity and a host of friends and WOC volunteers.
- Provided \$6,000 for 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Scholarship Program (6 students)
- Received over 60 produce boxes from Gwinnett County
- Received \$500 grant from Constellation Gas as Community Charity Award
- Received \$2,500 from Berean Christian Church Gwinnett
- Received \$8,500 special donation from personal donor
- Received \$250 from Alpha-Phi-Alpha Fraternity (RKL Education Foundation)
- Received 60+ bags of non-perishables from Margie's House
- Received \$250 award from Publix Gift Card
- WOC nominated for Gwinnett Chamber Small Business Award
- Held 12 WOC Monthly Women's Bible Studies. Average attendance: 6
- Fed 1<sup>st</sup> Responders (Snellville Fire Station 12) and Nicholas House Homeless Shelter for Thanksgiving
- Provided 200 Back-to-School supplies to Care 4 All Children Services, Nicholas House Homeless Shelter, Bethel Family Christian Church and Victory Baptist Church.




In 2021, over 60 families were offered non-perishable food items.
