Multi-State Expansion Enables Georgia-Based Nonprofit to Bring Education, Personal Development, and Community Engagement Services to Underserved North Carolina Communities

SNELLVILLE, GA – [November 5, 2025] – Words of Comfort Ministries, Inc. (WOC), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to restoring human dignity to the needy, announced today that it has received its Certificate of Authority from the North Carolina Secretary of State, enabling the organization to legally operate and provide services in North Carolina.

Founded in 2005 and headquartered in Snellville, Georgia, Words of Comfort Ministries has spent nearly two decades empowering individuals and families through economic and spiritual support. With the help of dedicated volunteers and partners, the organization serves those struggling with daily life challenges through three core service components: Education, Personal Development, and Community Engagement.

"This milestone represents a significant step forward in our mission to restore human dignity and deliver help and hope through service," said Dr. Gayle Daniels Gill, Founder/CEO of Words of Comfort Ministries. "God continues to open doors, and we are walking boldly through them. This expansion allows us to reach more people, touch more lives, and share God's love with underserved communities beyond Georgia's borders."

The organization's theme, "Together We Serve Promoting Greatness from Within," reflects its commitment to empowering individuals rather than creating dependency on social services. WOC's multifaceted approach includes direct services, empowerment programs, and comprehensive support designed to help individuals and families achieve self-sufficiency and personal growth.

About Words of Comfort Ministries' Service Model:

Words of Comfort Ministries identifies underserved populations and provides targeted services that address critical needs:

- **Education:** Literacy programs, job readiness training, and educational resources
- **Personal Development:** Life skills coaching, mentorship, and spiritual support
- **Community Engagement:** Connection to essential services, volunteer opportunities, and community-building initiatives

All programs focus on social change and increasing access to services for communities that have been historically underserved or marginalized.

The North Carolina expansion comes as Words of Comfort Ministries continues to grow its impact and reach. The organization's vision of delivering help and hope through service will now extend to North Carolina communities, with plans to establish partnerships with local churches, organizations, and community leaders.

This strategic decision has allowed WOC to maximize donor contributions by redirecting funds from administrative costs to mission-driven programs and services. In addition to financial savings, these spaces provide access to local business communities, fostering collaboration and enhancing WOC's ability to operate efficiently while expanding its reach.

2025/2024 Program Income Comparison




During the 2024-2025 fiscal period, the program income experienced a significant 23.1% increase, rising from \$21,868 to \$26,925.

- This financial growth, coupled with the strategic transition to co-working spaces in Georgia and North Carolina that slashed overhead by over 80%, has substantially amplified WOC's capacity to serve our community.
- By optimizing operational costs and simultaneously expanding our funding base, WOC has ensured that a much larger portion of every dollar directly supports our core mission of providing spiritual and emotional care.

Financial Highlights

5-Year Program Income Comparison

Our 2025 income of \$26,929 represents a 23% recovery from the previous year, affirming the strength of our mission even in a challenging economic landscape.



- A review of our five-year income trends reveals the profound impact of global and national volatility on our ministry's resources.
- After a peak in 2021–2022 (\$50,204 and \$50,153 respectively) supported by pandemic-era resilience, we experienced a contraction as emergency relief funds expired. This was compounded by widespread job losses that forced many smaller donors to prioritize essentials over philanthropy.
- Entering 2026, we are navigating an increasingly polarized political climate that has fostered funding instability and "donor paralysis," as many contributors face heightened uncertainty about the future.



Program Income/Expense Comparison




- In fiscal year 2025, Words of Comfort Ministries achieved a significant financial milestone by maintaining a \$6,024.87 operating surplus.
- With total income reaching \$26,929.75 against expenses of \$20,904.88, our organization has successfully balanced growth with extreme fiscal discipline.
- This positive margin is a direct result of our strategic move to co-working spaces and a leaner operational model, ensuring we remain solvent and prepared for future service expansion despite a volatile funding environment.
- By keeping our expenses at just 77% of our total income, we are building the essential reserves needed to sustain our mission through any season.

- In 2025, Words of Comfort Ministries generated \$26,929.75 in total program income, a figure that represents a vital recovery following recent economic volatility and job losses across the country.
- This strong financial foundation, combined with our commitment to responsible stewardship (as demonstrated by our 77% program expense allocation ratio), ensures we are equipped to expand our reach and maximize the impact of every dollar received.
